### **WELCOME**

Dear Parent,

Although this new period of home learning is not welcome for any of us, please be reassured that we will ensure that your child's learning journey continues smoothly.

This pack is designed to help you better understand the provision which will be in place over the coming weeks. That provision is not entirely fixed though, and we will regularly look for feedback from pupils and parents so that we can ensure that the offer is as calibrated to your needs as possible.

As your child's class teacher, I should be your first port of call in the event of any questions. I will be online throughout the school day (8.30 AM to 4.00 PM) and will respond to emails as swiftly as I am able to. There might be a slight delay if you contact me whilst I am in a video call or lesson with the children.

In planning this provision we have tried to be mindful of the need to balance time at the screen with time away from it, as well as strike the right balance between directed teaching and discussion and independent work. The children will not be required to be in front of a screen throughout the day, but at the same time they will be able to use technology to get assistance from it if they need to whilst working on an individual task.

### **GOOGLE MEET**

We will be using **GOOGLE MEET** for video teaching and for small group or one-to-one conversations. Similar to Zoom, which you are most likely familiar with, this free tool works on mobile phones, tablets, laptops and desktop computers.

No software needs to be installed, but apps are available for tablets and phones. These make it easier for the children, as they will not be prompted to login each time.

- In a browser on a laptop or computer, visit <u>https://meet.google.com</u>
- On an iPad or iPhone search for Google Meet on the App Store
- On an Android phone or tablet look for the Meet app, which should already be pre-installed



Google Meet will prompt you to log in, using a Google account. Your child has had a Dover College Google account created for them - details of the email address and password are on the next page.


### **GOOGLE MEET**

When your child joins the Google Meet they will see their teacher and other pupils as they join.





The controls, beneath the video feed, from left to right allow you to mute/unmute the microphone, to leave the call, to turn on/off the camera and to raise your hand (the teacher gets a notification of this).



For the lessons which do not involve Google Meet throughout, your child may wish to leave the call whilst they work independently. They can return at any time to speak to their teacher to get assistance.

There is no requirement that children have their camera turned on, but it is useful for the teacher to be able to see them so that they can ensure the appropriate level of engagement and pick up on any difficulties.


On **Dover College Online** your child will find a range of additional academic and co-curricular enrichment activities.

- Some pupils may wish to click **Academic Enrichment**, to explore some of the subject based resources aimed for Senior School pupils


# **WEEKLY ASSEMBLY**
