At Dover College Nursery, we recognise that the early years are a time of extraordinary growth — not just physically, but emotionally, socially, and intellectually. Our approach to learning is both gentle and purposeful. Each day, children take part in focused phonics and maths sessions, carefully tailored to their stage of development. Through playful, engaging activities, they build strong early foundations in literacy and numeracy, developing key skills such as sound recognition, counting, and early reasoning. Weekly Spanish lessons are delivered by a qualified specialist teacher.

From learning to share and take turns to developing gross motor skills in PE lessons and coordination in music, our experienced staff ensure that every child is seen, valued, and supported — growing not just in knowledge, but in character and confidence, every single day.

Our Nursery is set within a secure, leafy green campus in the heart of Dover, offering a peaceful and inspiring environment for young children to thrive. In addition to a dedicated Early Years playground, pupils benefit from access to the beautiful 12th century Priory site, where history and nature come together to enrich their daily experience. This unique setting offers space to play, explore and imagine — all within a safe and nurturing atmosphere that helps children feel part of something bigger.

Mealtimes are another opportunity to foster community. Children have the option to enjoy a nutritious, hot cooked lunch each day, freshly prepared by our in-house catering team and served in the Refectory alongside our Prep School pupils. This shared experience helps instil positive social habits and a strong sense of belonging from the very start.

Our Nursery offers exceptional flexibility for busy families, open from 7.00 am to 6.00 pm, Monday to Friday, for 50 weeks of the year. With a convenient one-way drop-off system through the school site and just a one-minute walk from Dover Priory station, our location is ideally placed for commuting parents. We combine high-quality care with practical convenience, ensuring that every child — and every family — enjoys a smooth and happy start and end to the day.

Fees

Government Funding

Dover College participates in the Kent County Council's Free Early Education Entitlement for eligible 2, 3 and 4-year-olds.

- We offer the 30-hour funding as 24 hours per week, delivered as Monday – Thursday 9:00 – 14:00 and Fridays 9:00 – 13:00 over 48 weeks per year.
- The 15-hour funding is offered as 12 hours per week, delivered as 9:00 – 12:00 4 days a week subject to availability over 48 weeks per year.

The Nursery is open 50 weeks per year. The funded hours cover 48 weeks per year. The remaining two weeks, if required, are charged at £300 per week (£60 per day).

Fees for Additional (Non-Funded) Hours

- Breakfast Club (08.00 - 9.00): £8.50
- Afternoon session (14.00 - 16.00): £17
- Late session (16.00 - 17.30): £15
- Full day (8.00 - 5.30): £30

Non-Funded Fees

- Full Day (8.00 am – 4.00 pm): £60
- Morning Session (8.00 am – 12.00 pm): £37.50
- Afternoon Session (12.00 pm – 4.00 pm): £37.50

Late Collection Fee

An initial charge of £10.00 for the first 5 minutes past the agreed session end time and then £1.00 per minute will be charged thereafter for any late collection from the agreed session end time.

Food

- Snack: £1.50
- Hot lunch (two courses): £3 per day

Uniform

At Dover College, we aim to ensure that our youngest pupils are comfortable, active, and easily identifiable as part of our school community. To support this, all Nursery children are asked to wear:

- A crested black sweater (two will be supplied by the school upon enrolment -further sweaters can be purchased)
- A plain red polo shirt
- Plain black shorts or jogging bottoms (no branding is permitted)
- White socks
- Trainers
- Suitable waterproof clothing for Forest School
